	I will do a short ident before and my eyes will speak volumes when performing
	I have a pen and paper to write down the numbers of potentially useable takes
	I have preregistered software for editing and sending and know my passwords
	I will rename the file with my name and the production name before sending it
	I will keep the final edit and copy myself and my agent in when I send the tape
